Official visit of a delegation from the Court of Justice of the European Union to the German Federal Constitutional Court

As part of the regular contacts which the Court of Justice of the European Union maintains with the highest courts of the Member States, a delegation from the Court of Justice today made an official visit to the German Federal Constitutional Court (Bundesverfassungsgericht), at its invitation.
