*Officials — Staff report — Change in the method of making the report — Correlation between the old and the new method — Limits
(Staff Regulations, Art. 43)*

Where an institution seeks to make finer distinctions in the analytical assessment of officials when reports are made on them by substituting in place of a method of assessment based on three assessments of a general nature, 'above average', 'average' and 'below average', a method of

assessment based on six headings and subheadings for 'ability' and four headings for 'efficiency' and 'conduct in the service' respectively, such a change in method necessarily implies that there can be no fixed correlation between the old and the new method of making the report.
