Formal sitting of 30 November 2005

On 9 November 2005 Ms Waltraud Hakenberg was appointed Registrar of the European Union Civil Service Tribunal by the Judges of the Court of First Instance for a term of six years, from 30 November 2005 to 29 November 2011.

At 18.30 today in Luxembourg, the European Union Civil Service Tribunal held a formal sitting at which Ms Hakenberg took the oath as Registrar of the European Union Civil Service Tribunal. This is the first time that the European Union Civil Service Tribunal has sat.

Born 1955; studied law in Regensburg and Geneva (1974-79); first State examination (1979); postgraduate studies in Community law at the College of Europe, Bruges (1979-80); trainee lawyer in Regensburg (1980-83); Doctor of Laws (1982); second State examination (1983); lawyer in Munich and Paris (1983-89); official at the Court of Justice of the European Communities (1990-2005); Legal Secretary at the Court of Justice of the European Communities (in the Chambers of Judge Jann, 1995-2005); teaching for a number of universities in Germany, Austria, Switzerland and Russia; Honorary Professor at Saarland University (since 1999); member of various legal committees, associations and boards; numerous publications on Community law and Community procedural law.
