All European Final of the European Moot Court Competition takes place at the Court of Justice of the European Union in Luxembourg on 28 March

The European Law Moot Court Competition is the world's largest Moot Court in EU Law. Organised for the first time during the 1988-1989 academic year, this competition has as its primary objective to promote practical knowledge of EU law amongst law students.

Law students, who have already made their way through a tough selection of around 70 teams since September 2013 when the European Law Moot Court Competition was launched, will plead before panels composed of Members of the Court of Justice, the General Court and the Civil Service Tribunal of the European Union. The competing teams represent seven universities from different countries. They won their respective Regional Finals which were held in February 2014 in Aix-en-Provence, Braga, Bratislava and Turin.

Students from all EU member states participated in the competition. Those who participated in the Regional Finals also included students from non-EU countries, notably the USA.

The final is the last stage of this competition, which has been held at the Court of Justice since 1991. The winners will receive various prizes, including internships with European Institutions or highly respected law firms specialising in European law.
