Official visit of the Court of Justice of the European Union to Poland

As part of the constant contact which the Court of Justice of the European Union maintains with the highest courts of the Member States, a delegation from the Court is to pay an official visit, from Wednesday 9 April to Friday 11 April 2014, to the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Poland at its invitation.

The delegation will comprise Mr V. Skouris, President of the Court of Justice, Mr K. Lenaerts, Vice-President, Messrs A. Tizzano, M. Ilešič, L. Bay Larsen, M. Safjan, J. L. Da Cruz Vilaça, Presidents of Chambers, Ms J. Kokott, Advocate General, Messrs G. Arestis and A. Arabadjiev, Judges, Ms C. Toader, Judge and Mr M. Szpunar, Advocate General.

On the occasion of this visit, the delegation will be welcomed by H.E. Mr B. Komorowski, President of the Republic of Poland, and will be present at the Annual General Meeting of the judges of the Constitutional Court.

On Thursday 10 April, the delegation will hold three working sessions with the judges of the Constitutional Court, the Supreme Court and the Supreme Administrative Court; the first working session will cover administrative penalties and criminal penalties in the case-law of the Court of Justice of the EU and that of the Constitutional Court, the second will cover the application of the Charter of Fundamental Rights in the Member States of the EU and the third, the dialogue between national judges and the Court of Justice.
