



Approval of the proposed reform of the judicial framework of the Court of Justice of the European Union

The President of the Court of Justice of the European Union, Mr Koen Lenaerts, the President of the General Court of the European Union, Mr Marc Jaeger, and the President of the Civil Service Tribunal of the European Union, Mr Sean Van Raepenbusch, welcome the approval by the legislative authorities of the European Union of the proposed reform of the judicial framework of the Court of Justice of the European Union, which provides for an increased number of Judges at the General Court and changes in the structure of the institution with the incorporation of the Civil Service Tribunal into the General Court.

The approval of this reform marks the completion of a long legislative process and will, thanks to the reinforcement of the General Court, make it possible for the institution to continue to perform its tasks in the service of persons subject to EU law in compliance with the objectives of justice of high quality and efficiency.

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
