The Court of Justice of the European Union adds its voice to the tributes paid to the victims of the attacks of 13 November in Paris

The President of the Court of Justice of the European Union has expressed, on behalf of the institution, his most heartfelt sympathy and his solidarity in condolence messages sent today to the French authorities following the attacks which struck Paris.

The Court of Justice of the European Union fully shares the pain and fear inflicted by the attacks and stands at France's side in the face of this tragedy. Furthermore, at midday the Members and staff of the institution gathered symbolically around *The Thinker* by Auguste Rodin, which is on display at the heart of the gallery linking the various buildings of the institution, to observe a minute's silence in memory of the victims.
