All European Final of the European Moot Court Competition takes place at the Court of Justice of the European Union in Luxembourg on 20 April 2012

Law students, who have already made their way through a tough selection of seventy teams since September 2011 when the European Law Moot Court Competition was launched, will today plead before panels composed of Members of the Court of Justice, the General Court and the Civil Service Tribunal of the European Union. The teams who are competing today represent eight universities from different countries. They won their respective Regional Finals which were held in February 2012 in Luxembourg, Braga, Lucerne and Istanbul.

Students from all EU member states participated in the competition. Those who participated to the Regional Finals also included students from countries such as Croatia, Bosnia Herzegovina, Turkey, the USA, Canada and China.

The Final is the last stage of this year's competition, the world's largest Moot Court in European law. The winners will receive various prizes, including internships with European Institutions or highly respected law firms specialising in European law.
