## Mr Marc van der Woude is elected Vice-President of the General Court of the European Union

Following the partial replacement of the Members of the General Court of the European Union<sup>1</sup> and the election of the President of the General Court,<sup>2</sup> Mr Marc van der Woude, Judge at the General Court since 13 September 2010, has been elected by his peers to serve as Vice-President of the General Court for the period from 20 September 2016 to 31 August 2019.
