Visit to the Court of Justice of the European Union by the President of the Czech Republic, Mr Petr Pavel

Today, the President of the Czech Republic, Mr Petr Pavel, visited the Court of Justice of the European Union. He was accompanied by Mr Milan Vašina, Head of the Office of the President, Mr Jaroslav Zajíček, Director of the Foreign Policy Department at the Office of the President, Mr Vladimír Bärtl, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Czech Republic to the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg and Mr Ronald Dofing, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg to the Czech Republic.

Mr Pavel was welcomed by Mr Koen Lenaerts, President of the Court of Justice, Mr Jan Passer, Judge at the Court of Justice, and Ms Petra Škvařilová-Pelzl and Mr David Petrlík, Judges at the General Court, and was invited to sign the Livre d'Or of the Court.

He met President Lenaerts, with Mr Eduard Hulicius, Deputy Minister for Foreign Affairs, Mr Vašina, Mr Bärtl, Mr Dofing, Mr Zajíček, Mr Passer, Mr Marc van der Woude, President of the General Court, Ms Škvařilová-Pelzl and Mr Petrlík in attendance, after visiting the Main Courtroom of the Court.

Lastly, Mr Pavel and the Czech delegation met with Czech staff members of the institution in the Salle des pas perdus in front of the painting Na cestě by the Czech painter Míla Doleželová.
