Formal sitting of the Court of Justice

Entry into office of a new Member at the General Court of the European Union

By decision of 29 March 2017, the representatives of the governments of the Member States appointed Mr Colm Mac Eochaidh as Judge at the General Court of the European Union for a term of office expiring on 31 August 2019.

A formal sitting of the Court of Justice will take place today on the occasion of the taking of the oath of the new Judge called upon to take up office.
