



Entry into office of a new Member at the General Court of the European Union

By decision of 6 September 2017, the representatives of the governments of the Member States appointed Mr Geert De Baere as Judge at the General Court of the European Union for a term of office expiring on 31 August 2022.

A formal sitting of the Court of Justice will take place today on the occasion of the taking of the oath of the new Judge called upon to take up office.
