Formal sitting of 6 February 2019

By decision of 1 February 2019, the representatives of the governments of the Member States appointed Mr Priit Pikamäe, who replaces Mr Nils Wahl, as Advocate General at the Court of Justice for the period from 5 February 2019 to 6 October 2024.

A formal sitting of the Court of Justice will be held today on the occasion of the departure from office of Mr Nils Wahl and of the entry into office of Mr Priit Pikamäe.
