CELEBRATION OF THE 30th ANNIVERSARY OF THE GENERAL COURT

The General Court in the Digital Age

A ceremony took place today at the Court of Justice of the European Union to celebrate the thirtieth anniversary of the establishment of the General Court of the European Union. The first members of that court, setup by the Council Decision of 24 October 1988, had taken up their duties on the 25th September 1989.

A commemorative colloquium was held with the theme "The General Court of the European Union in the Digital Age" in the presence of numerous representatives of European, national and international institutions, as well as law professors, judges, lawyers and lawyers from all the Member States. The colloquium was opened with the speeches of Mr. Marc Jaeger, President of the General Court, Mr. José Luis da Cruz Vilaça, first President of the General Court and Ms. Sam Tanson, Minister of Culture, Housing and Justice of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg.

The colloquium was organized around two themes: "Accessible justice" and "Efficient and Quality Justice", and ended with a concluding speech by Mr. Koen Lenaerts, President of the Court of Justice of the European Union.
