Mr Savvas Papasavvas is elected Vice-President of the General Court of the European Union

Following the partial replacement of the Members of the General Court of the European Union,¹ Mr Savvas Papasavvas has been elected to serve as Vice-President of the General Court for the period from 27 September 2019 to 31 August 2022. He succeeds Mr Marc van der Woude.
