Entry into office of a new member of the General Court of the European Union

By decision of 8 September 2021, the representatives of the Governments of the Member States appointed Mr Pēteris Zilgalvis as Judge of the General Court of the European Union for the period from 10 September 2021 to 31 August 2025.
