## CALL FOR APPLICATIONS N° CJ AP 21/24

Judge Ulf Öberg, of the General Court of the European Union in Luxembourg, seeks a suitable applicant for the position of Legal Secretary which will become vacant within his chambers on 7 October 2024.

Applicants must have a law degree. Expertise in competition law, State aid law, anti-dumping law, digital markets law and procedural law, as well as significant experience in a similar position in the chambers of a judge of the Court of Justice or General Court or national courts, as a judge or as a practicing lawyer, will be particularly valued.

As the working language of Judge Öberg's chambers is English, candidates must be completely professionally competent in this language. In-depth knowledge of French and/or Swedish will be considered an asset.

The position is to be filled either by the engagement of a temporary agent, or by the secondment of an official in the interests of the service.
