Publication of statements of case and written observations submitted in preliminary ruling cases

Statements of case or written observations submitted in preliminary ruling cases by the interested persons referred to in Article 23 of the Statute of the Court of Justice of the European Union are, in accordance with the fifth paragraph of that provision, to be published on the website of the Court of Justice of the European Union within a reasonable time after the closing of the case, unless the author of those submissions raises objections to their publication.

Article 96(3) of the Rules of Procedure of the Court of Justice provides that such objections must be communicated to the Registry, by separate document, no later than three months after the delivery of the judgment or service of the order closing the proceedings.

In view of the above, statements of case or written observations that are submitted in preliminary ruling cases closed after 1 September 2024 – the date of entry into force of Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2024/2019 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 April 2024 amending Protocol No 3 on the Statute of the Court of Justice of the European Union (OJ L 2024/2019, 12.8.2024) – are published on the website of the Court of Justice of the European Union, subject to any objections raised by their author. The documents published on the website are the original version of the statement or observations lodged as well as the available translations of those submissions, redacted of any personal data they might contain. For the purpose of drawing up those versions, the original documents undergo technical processing as a result of which their formatting may be slightly altered.
