Summary of the Order

*Actions for annulment — Action for annulment of a decision adopted under the ECSC Treaty — Action brought by a regional authority of a federal State — Inadmissible (ECSC Treaty, Art. 33; EC Treaty, Art. 173)*

A federal regional authority is not entitled to bring an action seeking annulment of a decision adopted under the ECSC Treaty since such authorities are not referred to by Article 33 of the ECSC Treaty, which pro-

vides an exhaustive list of the persons entitled to bring an action for annulment, and Article 173 of the EC Treaty cannot apply to such an action.
