

**Order of the Court of First Instance (Fifth Chamber, Extended Composition) of
27 January 2006 — Van Mannekus v Council**

(Case T-280/03)

Dumping — Imports of dead-burned (sintered) magnesia originating in China —
Amendment of anti-dumping measures previously imposed — Action for
annulment — Objection of inadmissibility

*Actions for annulment — Natural or legal persons — Measures of direct and
individual concern to them (Art. 230, fourth para., EC) (see paras 108-116, 121)*

Operative part

The Court:

1. Dismisses the action;
2. Orders the applicant to bear its own costs and those of the Council;
3. Orders the Commission to bear its own costs.
