What will your contribution be?

- Manage complex data flows, identify key areas of attention related to data quality, performance, and reliability, and propose recommendations in line with the Court's operational requirements and priorities.



- Draft technical documentation aimed at supporting the understanding, monitoring, evaluation, and continuous improvement of data integration processes.
- Contribute to enhancing the quality and governance of the data products created within the Court's environment.
