

Publication of statements of case and written observations submitted in preliminary ruling cases

Statements of case or written observations submitted in preliminary ruling cases by the interested persons referred to in Article 23 of the Statute of the Court of Justice of the European Union are, in accordance with the fifth paragraph of that provision, to be published on the website of the Court of Justice of the European Union within a reasonable time after the closing of the case, unless the author of those submissions raises objections to their publication.

Article 202(3) of the Rules of Procedure of the General Court provides that such objections must be communicated to the Registry, by separate document, no later than three months after the person concerned has been informed that no proposal to review the decision of the General Court has been made by the First Advocate General, or after service of the decision of the Court of Justice not to review the decision of the General Court, or after delivery of the judgment reviewing the latter decision.

In view of the above, statements of case or written observations that are submitted in preliminary ruling cases closed by the General Court are published on the website of the Court of Justice of the European Union, subject to any objections raised by their author. The documents published on the website are the original version of the statement or observations lodged as well as the available translations of those submissions, redacted of any personal data they might contain. For the purpose of drawing up those versions, the original documents undergo technical processing as a result of which their formatting may be slightly altered.
