

United Civil Chambers, ruling [ordinanza] of 25 June 2021 No 18299, legally summarised as follows:
«On the jurisdiction of Italian courts over aliens. Pursuant to Article 3(2) of Law No 218/1995, when the defendant is domiciled in another EU Member State, in compliance with the criteria set out by Regulation (EU) No 1215/2012 - which replaced Regulation (EC) No 44/2001, which in turn replaced the 1968 Brussels Convention - Italian courts are competent when the matters at issue were already included within the scope of the Brussels Convention of 27 September 1968 » (Rv. 661653-01)
